

Dreaming of Ice Drops

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Materials:

Shuttle and Ball

Glass gem of 1" or $\frac{3}{4}$ "

Thread #10

The ice drop is made in one pass



Ring: 8 --- 8 --- 8 --- 8 --- 8. Make a mock picot. The picots on this ring are long enough to go to the middle of the gem's side.

Leave a short amount of thread (the size of half picot of previous ring) and make another ring.

Ring: 8 --- 8 --- 8 --- 8 --- 8. Tie the thread to make another mock picot.



This is how it looks when you finish both rings.

Chain: 8. Make a shoelace trick.

Ring: 2 --- 2 --- 2 --- 2 --- 2. Make a shoelace trick.

Chain: 8. Make a lock join through the next picot on both rings.

Repeat this 3 more times.

Insert the gem and repeat the chain, ring, chain twice. Join to the beginning mock picot.

Make a ric rac chain of 1 regular double stitch and 1 unflipped double stitch, 20 times; for the hanging loop.



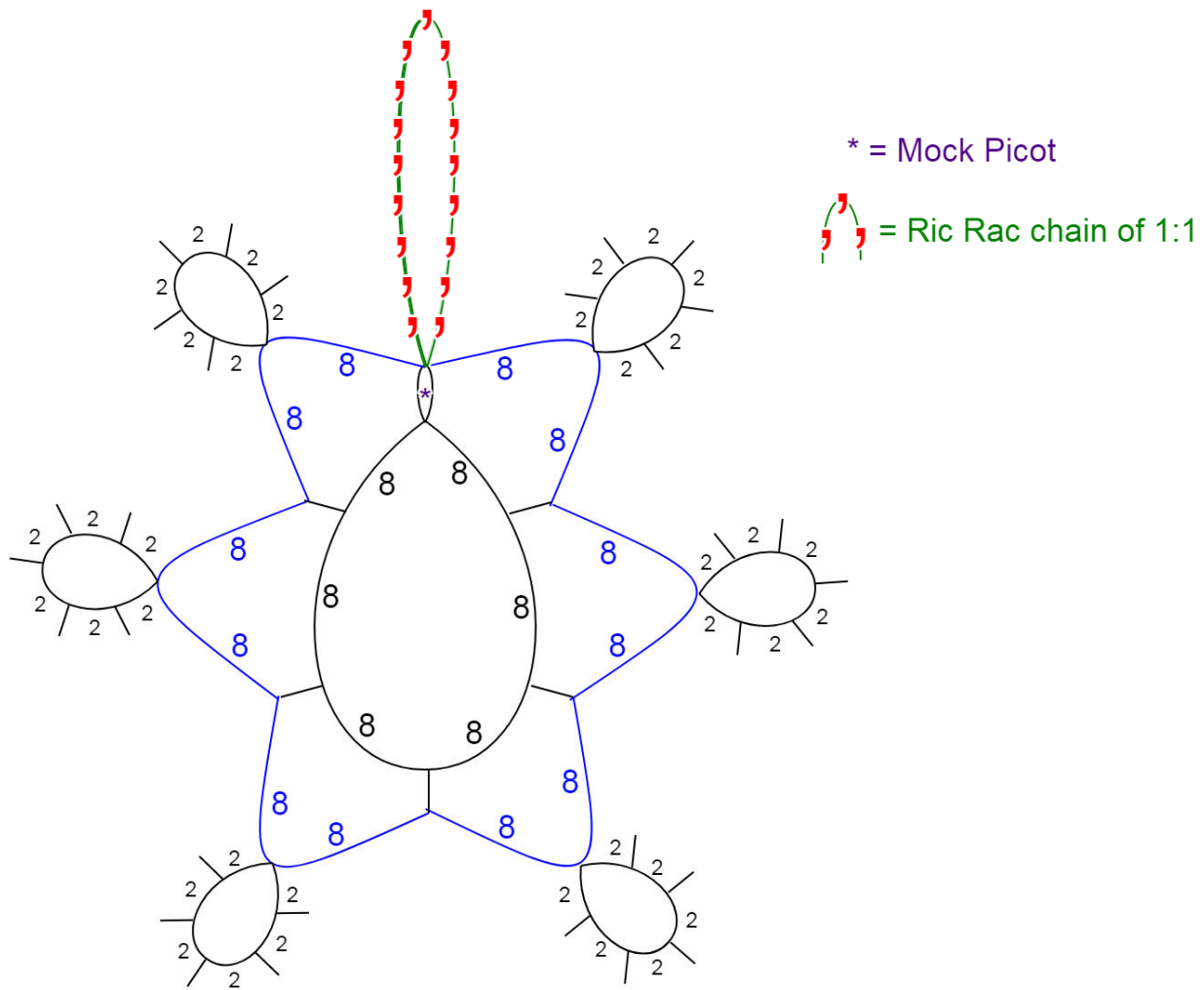
This is how the ice drop looks on its side.
