

Napkin Ring

Materials:

Shuttle and Ball
Thread #10
6mm Pearl

Instructions:

STRIP:

R: 10 vsp 10. RW.

CH: 5 - 2 --- 2 - 5. Join to the vsp. RW.

Repeat ring and chain for the desired length. In this photo I made 8 repetitions.

Don't RW when you reach the last chain and join it to the last ring, using the chain's thread join to the other end of the strip, creating a ring. Continue working the chain around the side. Tie and hide ends.

FLOWER:

Leaving a tail of 4 inches.

R: 5 - 5 - 2 --- 2 - 5 - 5.

R: 5 + 5 - 2 --- 2 - 5 - 5.

Repeat until 4 petals are made.

Last R: 5 + 5 - 2 --- 2 - 5 + (join to the 1st petal) 5.

Tie and leave a long tail. Use this tail to sew the pearl to the center of the flower and then sew the flower to the center of the strip, between to rings.

You can stiff the band if desired. I found that the Aunt Lydia's that comes in the huge ball is stiff enough and with a tight tension the band won't need stiffening.
